WHY UNITED WAY?

United Way of Southwestern Indiana responds to the needs of families and individuals right here in our own back yard in Vanderburgh, Warrick and Spencer counties.

When you give to United Way of Southwestern Indiana, you are helping to support:

- Our 2-1-1 Information and Referral Service answered over 21,000 calls in 2013, the leading request for help being food.
- Our 2014 Spring Into Caring Food Drive collected enough food to provide over 76,000 meals.
- Financial support to over 60 programs through 31 supported partner agencies.
- Our Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) sites filed 853 tax returns for individuals with last year's tax returns.
- The Early Childhood Development Coalition has enrolled nearly 900 children for the Napoleon Book Club Program.
- Our FAFSA volunteers completed 96 applications for families to access available financial aid for college.
- Our 2013 annual Day of Caring that provides over 880 individuals the opportunity to volunteer.
- Our Young Leaders United volunteered over 300 hours in projects for the common good of our community last year.
